

Cup of Tea

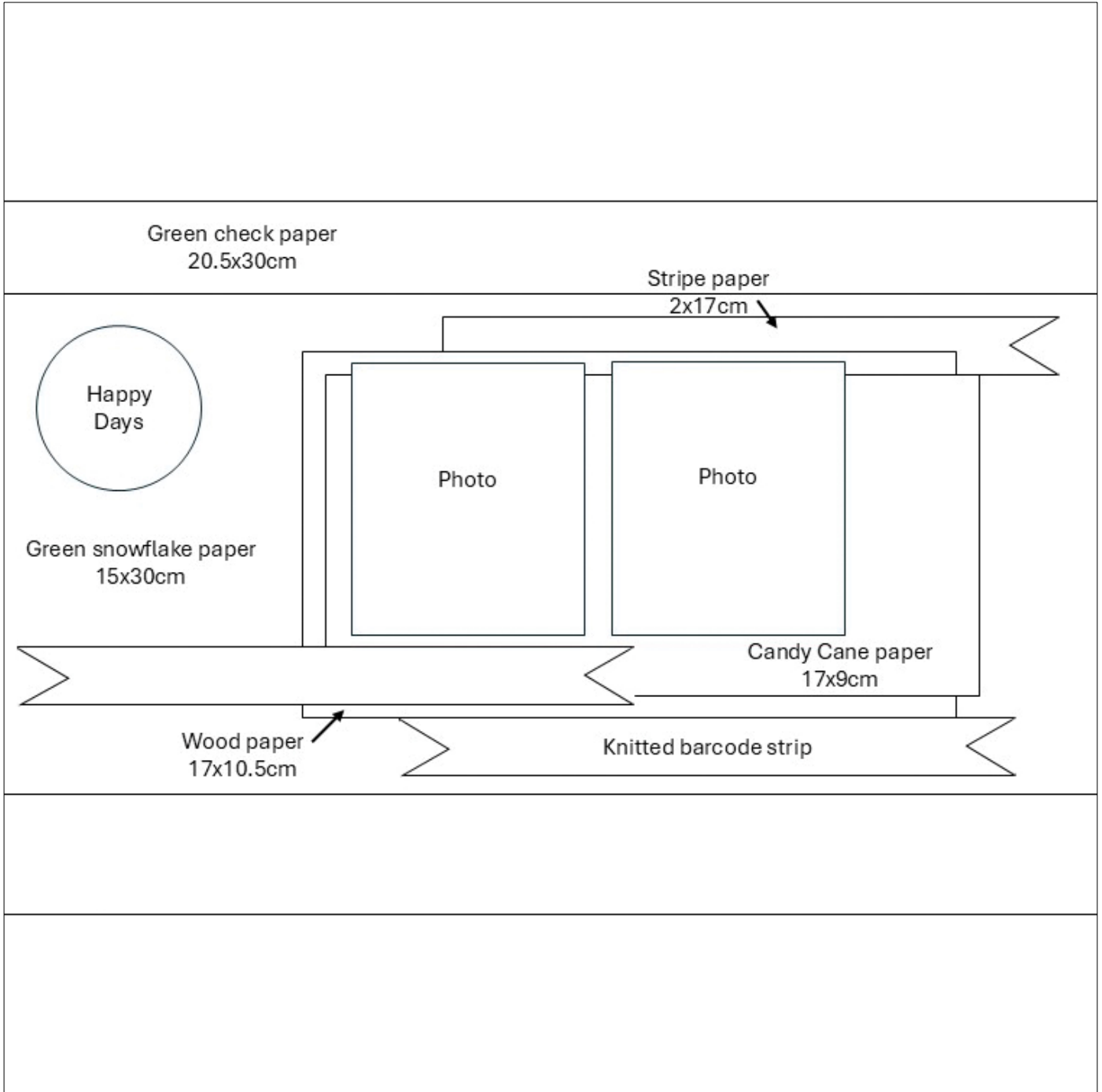

Happy Days

Products used:

- White cardstock
- Holly Jolly Christmas paper pack
- Pieces of ribbon and rope
- Eyelets and safety pin
- Foam tape
- Glue/Tape
- Lace



Instructions:

1. Cut a section of the green check paper to 20.5x30cm.
2. Cut a section of the green snowflake paper to 15x30cm.
3. Cut a section of the striped paper to 2x17cm.
4. Cut a section of the wood paper to 17x10.5cm.
5. Cut the candy cane paper to 9x17cm.
6. Place the candy cane paper over the wooden paper leaving 1cm from the left side and 1cm from the top.
7. Place the wooden paper on the green snowflake paper as illustrated on the diagram, just off centre.
8. Cut 2 barcode strips – I used the knitted strip and the red check strip.
9. Cut out the 'Happy Days' circular tag, punch a hole through the top centre and place an eyelet (if you don't have eyelets, just punch a hole and use as is).
10. Thread a piece of ribbon through the hole and hold it together with a safety pin.
11. Place your photos as shown on the candy cane paper.
12. I drew lines around my edges to give more detail to the 'plain' looking card, but you can use your discretion.
13. Place two strips of lace, place one on each the top and bottom of the green check paper.
14. Using some of your embellishments, decorate the rest of your page.
