

Cup of Tea

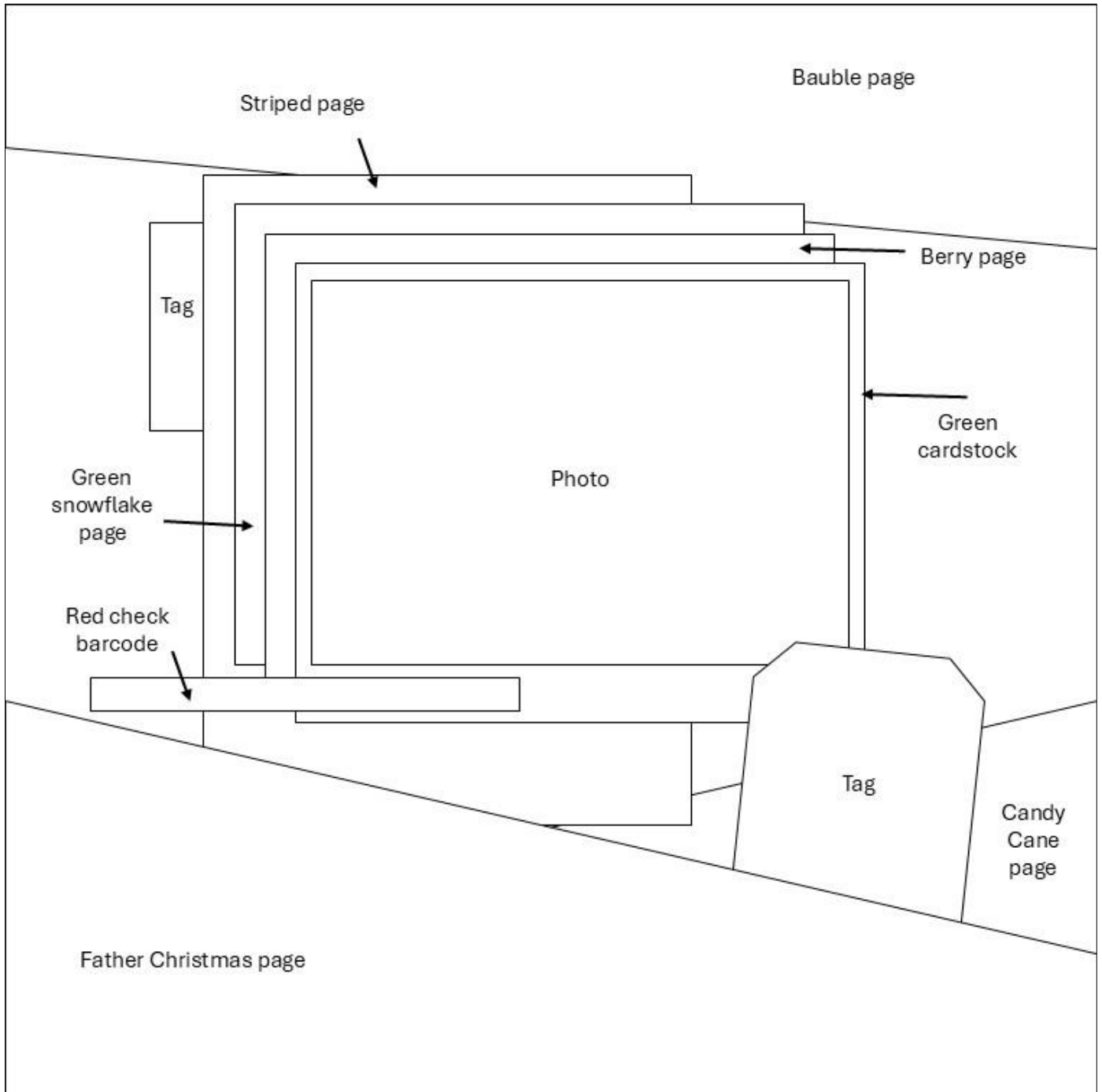

jingle bells

Products used:

- White cardstock
- Holly Jolly Christmas paper pack
- Pieces of ribbon and rope
- Green cardstock
- Eyelets and safety pin
- Foam tape
- Glue/Tape



Instructions:

1. Use your knitted paper as your background.
2. Tear the top and bottom sections of the bauble and Father Christmas to place as illustrated in the diagram – turn the candy cane page over and place under the Father Christmas page.
3. Cut the stripe paper to 17x13cm.
4. Cut the green snowflake paper to 15x12cm.
5. Cut the berry paper to 15x12cm.
6. Cut the green cardstock to 15x12cm.
7. Cut the 'Jingle Bells' tag, punch a hole top centre and thread a couple of pieces through it securing the ribbon with a safety pin.
8. Adhere the Candy Cane to the right hand side paper. Remember you need to make a pocket, so side and bottom sections only. Do the same with the Father Christmas section. Adhere left hand side, bottom and left sections only.
9. Cut out a tab to place under the striped paper. Before adhering the striped paper, tie a piece of rope underneath it and tie a knot around the front.
10. Layer the sections as illustrated.
11. Before you adhere the green cardstock, fold 2 ribbon pieces and adhere them under the card.
12. Place foam under the cardstock so that it stands off the berry paper.
13. Create embellished corners using a few of the embellishments you have cut out. Don't be afraid to raise them with foam and overlapping each other. I also rolled the edges of the 'ho,ho,ho'.
